# War correspondents' goal unchanged

## Methods, relationships differ from those of earlier days

BURKITTSVILLE, Md. (AP) — War reporting and the relationships between correspondents, governments and the military have changed dramatically since George Alfred Townsend set out on horseback in 1862 to cover the Civil War in Virginia.

But the mission of war correspondents, inscribed on a monument Townsend built to honor literary veterans of wars, remains the same: "To narrate distant wars and explore dark lands."

At age 20, Townsend was the youngest reporter covering the war. The native of Georgetown, Del., began his career with the Philadelphia Inquirer, worked for New York newspapers and later became a novelist during Reconstruction.

Townsend built the five-story memorial on a western Maryland hillside in the 1890s in recognition of more than 150 journalists and artists who covered the War Between the States. The monument was constructed with \$5,000 in contributions from people, including Joseph Pulitzer and Thomas Edison.

Today, the archway stands in a serene, wooded state park. Its setting is a stark contrast to today's hectic, high-stress job of reporting in Central America, the Middle East and other places where war and unrest have claimed the lives of an estimated 238 journalists since the 1930s.

Unlike during the Civil War, today's journalists must master complex political, religious and economic issues to tell the story of conflicts in places some Americans cannot pronounce.

But some of the problems that irked early war correspondents continue to plague their modern counterparts: censorship, manipulation by some governments that view reporters as propaganda tools, access, extreme working conditions and the media's relationship with military officials.

"The Civil War was complete anarchy as far as the press was concerned. The army didn't supply any help at all. There was no organization whatsoever," said John R. Wilhelm, dean emeritus at Ohio University who covered World War II for Reuters and the Chicago Sun-Times.

"We were highly organized in World War II. We were given the rank of captain and we were to be treated as such," he said. "We had organized press camps where they supplied us with motor vehicles, gasoline and drivers. We could go anywhere we wanted."

Their work, while easier, was still risky. "I was sitting having lunch in Belgium and German dive bombers came over and

blew the hotel apart and killed my best man, who was sitting next to me having lunch," he said.

Wilhelm, who reported on the Nazis' Buchenwald concentration camp with veteran broadcaster Edward R. Murrow, feels the U.S. military no longer provides the same level of assistance it did during World War II. In many cases, the media-military relationship has deteriorated, especially since the Vietnam War, he said.

There were front lines in World War II and reporters wrote about territorial advances. In Vietnam, journalists went into jungles with foot soldiers to cover fighting on a smaller scale. The United States sought to use the number of North Vietnamese and Vietcong killed as a measure of progress, but it didn't work because the counts often were exaggerated and conflicted with eyewitness reports, Vietnam War correspondents said.

Americans rallied behind the armed forces in World War II and had great affection for the work of Ernie Pyle whose folksy columns told the stories of individu-

al GIs.

But reporters in Vietnam often complained of having to sort through fact and fiction they got from military spokesmen who wanted to paint a rosy picture of Americans fighting there.

One former Vietnam correspondent said the military's response to factual reporting in Vietnam often was, "Why don't you get on the team?"

"I'm distressed at how the press and U.S. government relations since Vietnam have deteriorated to the extent that I don't think the U.S. media has a fair and clear access to this government's goings-on," said Donald G. North, 50, of Washington, who in 1967 won the Overseas Press Club award for his radio reports of Vietnam combat.

"The biggest obstacle today is the governments involved," he said. "Whether it's covering a war in Iraq or Iran, or in Israel, governments in the wake of Vietnam think it's wise or necessary to muzzle the press. The British did it in the Falkland Islands and we did it in Grenada."

The distrust between the military and U.S. media continued to widen in the years following Vietnam. In 1983, the United States excluded reporters from covering the early hours of America's invasion of Grenada.

Former Secretary of State George Shultz told a group of editors in December 1983 that in World War II, "reporters were involved all along. And on the whole, they were on our side." Now, he told them, "it seems as though the reporters are always against us ... they're always seeking to report something that's going to screw things up."

A month later, former President Jimmy Carter criticized the coverage restrictions in Grenada, saying they were "much more Draconian in nature, much more repressive in nature, than anything I remember in the history of our country."

Soon after, the U.S. government formed a commission to ease tensions between the media, military and government officials.
